John Pryor, a well-known trauma surgeon at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania was killed in Iraq on December 25, 2008.

“John was a man who truly believed that service to others was his calling,” said Dr. William Schwab, chief of trauma surgery and critical care at the hospital. “Whether it was volunteering at Ground Zero on 9/11 or with the Army, or serving the people of the community, that was what he was about.”

Of the 119 women who entered West Point in 1976 – smashing the well-known gender barrier – only 62 of them survived the grueling ordeal to graduate in 1980.
